

NOTICE OF RACE

2017 SAN JUAN 21 WESTERN NATIONALS CHAMPIONSHIP

Huntington Lake, California

July 21-23, 2017

1.0 **Rules**

1.1 The Regatta will be governed by the rules defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing

2.0 **Eligibility and entry**

2.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the San Juan 21 class. There will be two divisions: all sails and working sails.

(a) Boats participating in the "All Sails" division must use Class Main, Class Jib and Class Spinnaker.

(b) Boats participating in the "Working Sails" division may use Class Main and Class Jib only.

2.2 Each boat must complete the Registration, undergo measurements, meet the Article IV eligibility for Sanctioned Events requirements and pay all fees to the Organization Authority before becoming an official competitor to be scored.

3.0 **Fees**

See registration form for fees and additional items.

4.0 **Races**

4.1 All races to start at 11am depending on the wind.

5.0 **Measurements**

5.1 Boats that can show previous national measurements will not have to be re-measured. See measurement times for sailors that need to have sails measured.

6.0 **Radio Communications**

6.1 Except in an emergency, a boat while racing shall neither make nor receive radio communications. That includes cell phones.

7.0 **Sailing instructions**

7.1 Sailing instructions will be available upon registration.

8.0 **Venue**

8.1 Practice race Thursday at 1 pm

Sail measurement Thursday 9am to 11am and Friday 8:30am to 10am

First race Friday at 11am and Saturday at 11am; Sunday---11am if necessary

All information will be in the racing package upon registration

9.0 **Course**

9.1 Regattas location is Huntington Lake, California

9.2 Course will be according to Fresno Yacht Club race course set up.

10.0. **Scoring**

10.1 One race is required to complete the constituted series.

10.2 If six to ten scores have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total race scores excluding her worst score.

11.0 **Disclaimer of liability**

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk; See rule 4" Decision to race". The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.
